

LITTLE BOY BLUE FROM OVERSEAS FINDS GRANDMA

New York, Oct. 24—(U.P.)—The Little Boy Blue, whom the Red Cross brought by plane from across the sea where his parents died, had a name all the time, his grandmother said today.

Mrs. William Maloney, Grand Rapids, Mich., told of the secret marriage of her son, 1st Lt. Kenneth Maloney and an English

girl who died that Little Boy Blue might be born.
"My son was killed in a plane crash before he could tell me," Mrs. Maloney told a press conference. "Little Kenneth's mother died before she could. But the chaplain who married them wrote me about it. He said they didn't want to wait the six months for the commanding officer's consent."
"You're never going to be alone now. You'll be grandma's boy," she said to the chubby, six-months old baby. "You're going to be Kenneth Barry just like your daddy." She and the baby will begin a new life when they arrive home, she said.
"I was coming to New York in November to meet my son. He would have had a leave then,"

Mrs. Maloney said.
Like Son Born Again
"Now I've met his son instead, and I keep thinking the mother Kenneth has been born again."
She was proud of the little Kenneth, who "looks like his dad" and weighs 17 pounds when stripped down to his three-cornered britches, as he was last night when he arrived and was given a routine medical examination by the Red Cross. The Red Cross shepherded him on his plane trip from England.
The identity of the lot for whom President Roosevelt cut red tape so he could come to America aboard an army transport plane was to have been kept secret, but his grandmother inadvertently let the secret out in her home town.

She didn't mean to, she said, but her son had died in February, and his wife's parents cared for the baby until they were killed by a bomb, "and it was too wonderful having the baby to keep quiet."
