Oklahoma Removed From Navy Service

Pearl Harbor, Oct. 25—(U.P.) Adm. Chester W. Nimitz today announced that the 26-year-old, 29,000-ton battleship Oklahoma, sunk by the Japanese at Pearl Harbor and later salvaged and righted, has been de-commissioned and removed from naval service.

Battered by Japanese bombs and torpedoes on the morning of December 7, 1941, the Okla-

homa turned over and all but submerged.

She was righted and dry-docked in a brilliant engineering achievement, concluded December 28, 1943.

Restriction Lifted In Fishing Tackle

Washington, Oct. 25—(U.P.) The war production board has authorized limited production of fishing rods, reels and other types of non-commercial tackle and has lifted restrictions limit-

ing the manufacture of fish hooks.

WPB said the action "will not only help to supply returning servicemen with fishing tackle, but, to a limited extent, will also enable civilians to augment

their family food supply with fish."

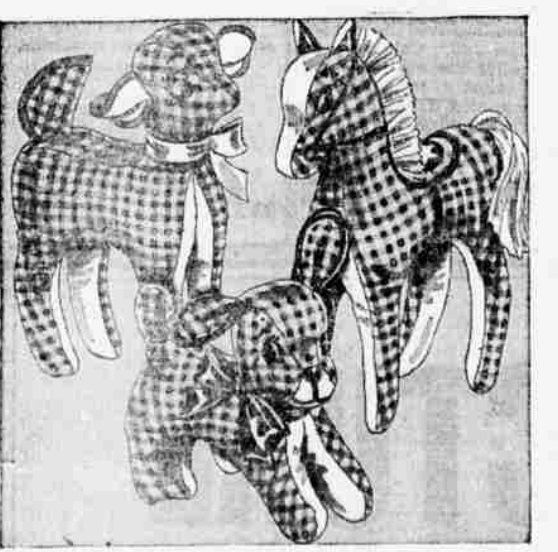
