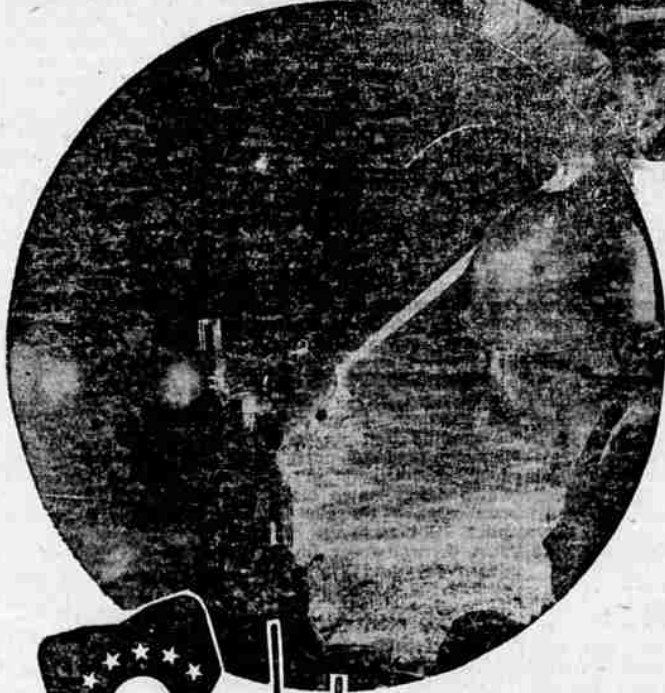


The flame thrower, one of the new basic infantry weapons to be explained and demonstrated in "Here's Your Infantry."
