

EXTENSION UNITS INVITED TO HEAR WORLD TRAVELER

Mrs. Helen Carlton Smith, world traveler and lecturer who has recently returned from England, will speak at an open meeting of Jackson county home economics extension units on Thursday, February 15, at the courthouse auditorium, at 1:30 p.m., according to Marian J. Farrell, home demonstration agent. The meeting will be open to the public. Mrs. Smith is vice chairman of the Associated Country Women of the World, an organization of rural women founded in 1930 to promote better understanding among the rural people of all nations. Since beginning of the war, Mrs. Smith has been working with the British ministry of information bringing to the English people a better understanding of American people and customs. Mrs. Smith has been active in the work of the Women's Institutes in England, which are comparable to our Home Extension Units. It is expected that she will tell of wartime conditions in England, and latest information on the progress of the Associated Country Women of the World. Preceding the meeting the home extension committees of Jackson, Josephine, Coos and Klamath counties will meet at the Holland Hotel for luncheon with Mrs. Smith.
