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BEWARE DOCTOR DECOY

This doctor claims he has made a change in the fluid used in the injection treatment of hernia, piles and varicose veins so that there will be no resulting ulcers. Please advise.

(Mrs. K.R.F.) With her inquiry Mrs. F. sends pages from a circular or brochure evidently used by the "doctor" to get customers. In it he quotes me (without my knowledge or consent—but then, charlatans think nothing of pirating on anybody's good name) as commending chemical obliteration (the injection treatment) for every sufferer from varicose veins. I do commend the method—but I warn you at the same time that it is reasonably safe only in the hands of a reliable physician or surgeon. I particularly warn you against submitting to such treatment at the hands of a self-recommended quack—and by quack I mean what Webster defines as a quack: A boastful pretender to medical skill. A boastful pretender spends a considerable share of the take telling the gullible portion of the population how skillful he is in treating this and that—he tells 'em in circulars, brochures, radio spots, newspaper ads, phony "lectures"—and he has to keep on telling 'em, for he knows that if he stops blowing his own horn his racket soon peters out, because, of course, he hasn't enough satisfied customers to keep him busy—you know or should know that it is the word of mouth commendation or advertising of the real doctor that builds his practice and his reputation. His satisfied patients refer their relatives and friends to him.

Now this charlatan who pretends he has discovered a trick or twist by which the chemical or medicine he injects will, say, shrink or shrivel or obliterate the varicose vein but without

(the implied) risk of causing varicose ulcer. In the first place, there is no such risk involved in the injection treatment of varicose veins, in the hands of a reliable, competent physician or surgeon—on the contrary, this treatment of the veins promotes healing of varicose ulcer in many instances.

Incidentally, the "doctor" who attempted to lure the prospect by that quackish inducement seems to be a near-doctor, perhaps a phony doctor, at any rate he is not a Doctor of Medicine—his name is not in the blue book which gives the names of all legally qualified M.D.'s in the United States and Canada. He uses only the non-committal or furtive title "Dr. Richard Roe"—which may mean that he is a veterinary or goodness knows what.

My advice to Mrs. K. R. F. is, consult a physician of standing in your community for injection treatment of varicose vein or varicose ulcer.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Would it be all right to give a child aged 9 years one-half of an adult size sulfa tablet every four hours?

(Mrs. L. D.) Answer—No. Personally I wouldn't take even a teeny dose of any sulfa drug unless I were sick under the care of my doctor. Sulfa drugs are far too dangerous to meddle with.

I am tired of being called "Chubby." Will you please send me your rules for reducing? (G. M.)

Answer—Ah-ah! A girl under eighteen cannot safely attempt reduction except under her own physician's care. If you are over eighteen mention your age, height and weight. If you sport the title Mrs. never mind these details. For booklet "Rules for Reducing" send 25 cents and stamped envelope bearing your address. It deals with glandular cases, as well as simple obesity. For pamphlet "How to Lose Weight" send stamped self-addressed envelope with your request. It deals with simple nutritional overweight.

Three Months of Calcium Feeding on Calcium. I was concerned about my fever which has made summers miserable for me for years. I supplemented my diet with calcium and vitamin D about three months before I experienced real improvement, but then I had the most comfortable season I remember, and in fact have enjoyed much better health and vigor since. Answer—Such treatment, whether for hay fever, asthma, allergy, headache, hyperactive rhinitis, tetany (leg cramps at night), weeping eczema, giant hives (angioneurotic edema), recurring chilblains, or other manifestations of calcium shortage, is not medicinal and hence should not be expected to produce effects in a day or a week. It is nutritional, and must be continued uninterruptedly for many weeks, as essential food.

POLES IN LONDON REJECT DECISION

London, Feb. 14 — (U.P.) — The London Polish government, as had been anticipated, announced last night that it rejects completely the Big Three decision on Poland.

After a lengthy cabinet meeting the London government announced that the decision of the Crimea conference "cannot be recognized by the Polish government and cannot bind the Polish nation."

The London statement said that the Crimea decision only would "legalize soviet interference in Polish internal affairs." "As long as the territory of Poland will remain under the sole occupation of soviet troops," said the statement, "a government of that kind will not safeguard the Polish nation—even in the presence of British and American diplomats—the unfettered right of free expression."

Steering Committee Favors George Bill

Washington, Feb. 14 — (U.P.) — The House Democratic Steering committee formally put party machinery in motion in support of the George bill today. Democratic leaders announced the measure would be brought before the house on Thursday.

The bill is intended to clear the way for confirmation of Henry A. Wallace as secretary of commerce. As passed by the senate, it would remove the huge Reconstruction Finance Corp. and other loan agencies from the commerce department.
