

NO DRINKS AFTER MIDNIGHT MONDAY BEER ALSO TABOO

Washington, Feb. 24.—(U.P.)—The war manpower commission, issuing regulations for the midnight closing of entertainment spots, ruled tonight that no alcoholic drinks may be served in any public places or private clubs after the curfew hour.

Restaurants which customarily remain open all night may continue to serve food after midnight, WMC said, but they may not serve any liquor—not even beer or ale. And they may not furnish any amusement, even juke boxes.

Restaurants which normally stay open an hour or two after midnight must close at 12 henceforth even for serving of food.

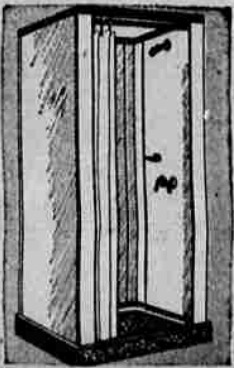

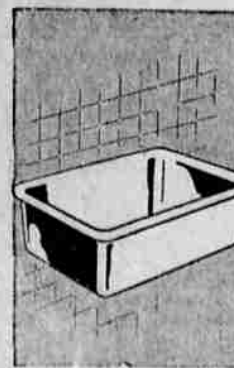

Tonight's order is effective at midnight Monday. It defines the curfew hour as midnight local time. It puts into operation the order issued last Monday by War Mobilization Director James F. Byrnes, who turned over to WMC the enforcement job. WMC in turn delegated the task to its 300 area directors, who will be aided by police and other local authorities.

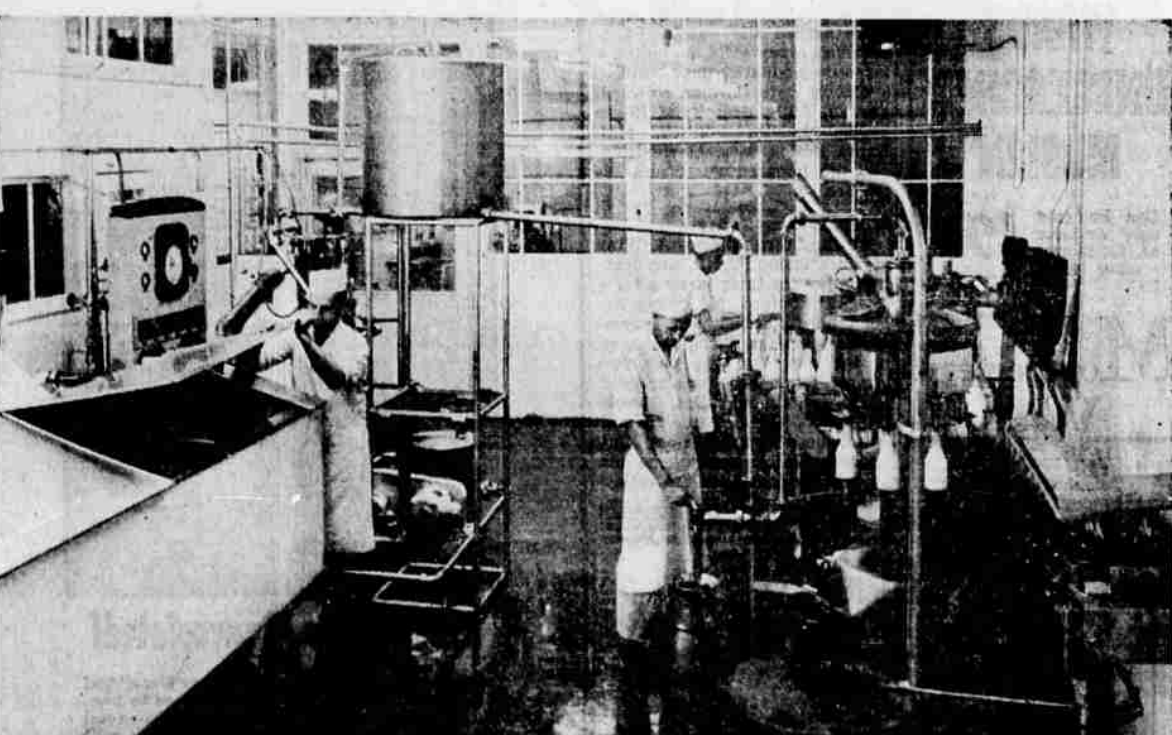
