MEDFORD YOUTHS ENLIST IN NAVY

Robert Day Porter, son of Mr. and Mrs. Elias H. Porter, route 1; Elroy Chester, son of Mr. and Mrs. Earl Chester, Medford, and Arnold E. Town, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank E. Town, route 1, were enlisted in the navy yesterday according to the Medford recruiting station. Young Chester and Town were enlisted as apprentice seamen and returned home to await call for "boot" training at the center in San Diego.

Because of his ability to pass the Eddy test, Porter was enlisted as a seaman first class, two steps above rating at which a recruit ordinarily begins. He will be sent home on inactive duty, pending graduation from high school in June, will be trained in radar at Chicago and later at some college or university, the navy recruiter states.

The favorable war news caught the stock market off balance and it crumpled easily. Before the announcement, the market had been under the influence of fears of further margin restrictions. 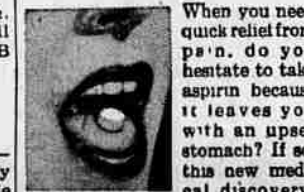
PATRICIA M. SAWYER

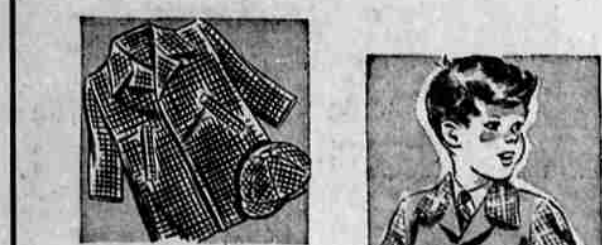

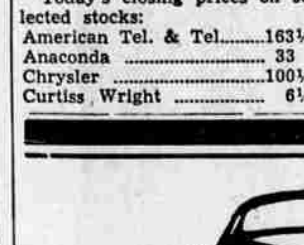
