## YOUR CLASS AND MINE

Most Americans get from two-  
 fifths to one-half of their cal-  
 ories from white flour and

sugar. These two highly nu-  
 tritious foods are free from

or relatively poor in vita-  
 mins, particularly vitamin

B1 (thiamine). Still some  
 who think what they're

talking about iterate and re-  
 iterate that people who are able

to select and enjoy a "well bal-  
 anced" diet including a liberal

variety of fresh fruits, vegeta-  
 bles, milk, eggs, meat etc., get

plenty of vitamins in their food.  
 This glib assurance is based

largely upon the widely pub-  
 lished dictum of the head bar-

ber for the best advertised  
 "clinic" that—

"The medical profession  
 would probably do well to point

out to worried dietitians and  
 mothers of families that disease

which can be definitely ascribed  
 to avitaminosis (lack of vitamins)

is very rarely seen among  
 American adults of the middle

and upper classes."

The mouthpiece of the best  
 advertised clinic, having con-  
 ceived and given birth to that

dictum without benefit of sci-  
 entific investigation, endeavored

to make it unanimous by adding  
 this modest confession of diag-  
 nostic ineptitude:

"Even the physician with a  
 very large practice will see only

a few cases a year in which he  
 will suspect that the symptoms

are due to too great a narrow-  
 ing of a diet."

(It is only fair to mention here  
 that the loquacious one went

overboard on this seven or eight  
 years ago, and no doubt has

learned better since.) This easy assumption that

adjudged dependent and a tem-
