SULPHUR AND MOLASSES

Mother thinks that flowers of sulphur is good to clean out the intestines and will not hurt one to take internally. Your advice about this will be appreciated by many. (Mrs. G. S.)

Come spring and sulphur and molasses—a usually queries about sulphur and "cleansing out the system" or "purifying the blood" begin to be frequent in the mail nearly a month before the biggest liar in the neighborhood sees the first robin. Up north, that is. Down south where it is always spring there are no robins.

Sulphur is a mild laxative. It is commonly used for that purpose in the form of compound licorice powder—a mixture of washed sulfur (flowers of sulfur), licorice powder, powdered senna leaves, fennel and sugar—this is now more correctly called compound senna powder, for it is chiefly the senna that gives the laxative effect.

Other than the mild laxative effect of sulfur it has no medicinal effect when given internally, so far as we know it is as nearly harmless as a laxative can be.

The notion that sulphur "purifies the blood" probably grew out of the observation that sulfurous physiochemists—the ancients imagined that anything that physicked somehow removed "impurities" from the blood—what "impurities" nobody but the quacks knew and, for protection of the trade the quacks never told.

If you are fond of fusing there is no harm at all in mixing up a mess of flowers of sulfur or washed sulfur and molasses—pound for pound or ounce for ounce—and taking a teaspoonful or a tablespoonful once a day on empty stomach—say at bedtime—for a few weeks in the spring. By the time the big thaw comes you'll be ready to take advantage of the improv-

Much-Wed Woman Strong For Navy Is Claim By FBI

San Francisco, March 13—(U.P.)—Mrs. Virginia Jorgensen, who numbered four husbands among her nine husbands since 1891, today was charged in a federal complaint with fraudulent obtaining of servicemen's allowance checks.

Mrs. Jorgensen was arrested by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and arraigned before the U. S. commissioner.

Nat Pieper, special agent in charge of the FBI office here, said Mrs. Jorgensen's last four husbands were navy enlisted men and that the last time she was ever applied for a divorce was after her fourth marriage in 1940.

The charge against her carries a fine up to \$2,000 or a jail sentence up to one year, or both.

Lighting
Using goose-neck lamp with blue glass covering opening. Some experts say this type of lamp is bad for reading or studying as there is too great contrast between the illuminated field and the unlighted parts of the room. (V. A.)

Answer—It is better to have sufficient but not too intense light on the work and moderate light on all other parts of the room. Source of light should be a few feet above your eyes and behind your plane of vision, a foot or two to left or right as you find more comfortable.

On Third Bushel
Many thanks to you, my husband and myself are now on our third bushel of wheat. (Mrs. M. M.)

Answer—Plain wheat is (1) economical, (2) more nutritious than any refined wheat product, (3) a wholesome item to replace the pap know as "breakfast food," (4) might give eating bread made with it a bearing your address, for pamphlet "Wheat to Eat" which tells you why you should eat plain wheat every day and how to prepare it for the table.

Pica

Answer—No. Many normal babies are fond of wet soil, sand, and rascal soil and the like. Such appetite is called "pica." No special significance. Perhaps the child may be unsatisfied with more wholesome things such as wheat, bran, raw oatmeal, raw carrot, turnip, potatoes, baked potato.
