

ROGUE RIVER DAM PROJECT INCLUDED

The Medford-Sams Valley-Debenger gap project on Rogue river, at an estimated cost of \$13,740,000 was among the twenty Oregon irrigation, flood control and power projects included in the revised postwar construction plan of the reclamation bureau, reported to congress last week. Overall cost of the projects was estimated to cost nearly \$100,000,000. In addition to irrigating 31,150 acres and providing 13,200 acres with supplemental water, the Debenger gap project is planned for flood control and

development of 7,000 KW of power.
