## FORGER IS GIVEN THREE YEAR TERM

Wyatt Drennan, Jr., charged with forgery, was sentenced to an indeterminate term of not to exceed three years in state prison by Circuit Judge H. K. Hanna yesterday on a plea of guilty. The defendant's counsel contended Drennan wrote the bogus checks only when under the influence of liquor. ## No Reduction in Calls For Draft

Washington, May 4.—(U.P.)—Prospects of a reduction in draft calls during the next few months got a sharp setback today from Chief of Staff Gen. George C. Marshall.

In a letter to Chairman Andrew J. May, D. Ky., of the house military affairs committee Marshall pointed out that the army has not been able to meet replacement demands of Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower and Douglas MacArthur for May and June, and that Eisenhower's current losses are running at 2,000 men daily.

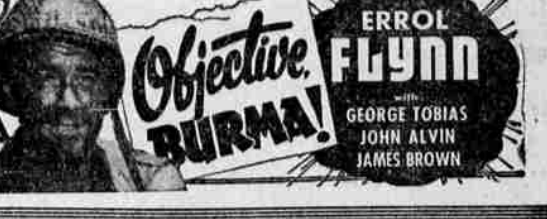
