

**Cordon's Son Gets Medal For Heroism At Overseas Base**

The soldier's medal has been awarded First Lt. Allen Cordon, son of Senator and Mrs. Guy Cor-

don, Roseburg, for heroism at a Twelfth AAF Thunderbolt base, according to an army release. According to the citation, Lt. Cordon assisted in extinguishing a fire and in removing valuable government property from the path of the flames, despite intense heat and explosions of ammunition.

Lt. Cordon is serving as a public relations officer at the base. Before entering the service he was with the patrol and investigation division of the Oregon state police. The officer's wife and son, David, reside in Washington, D. C.

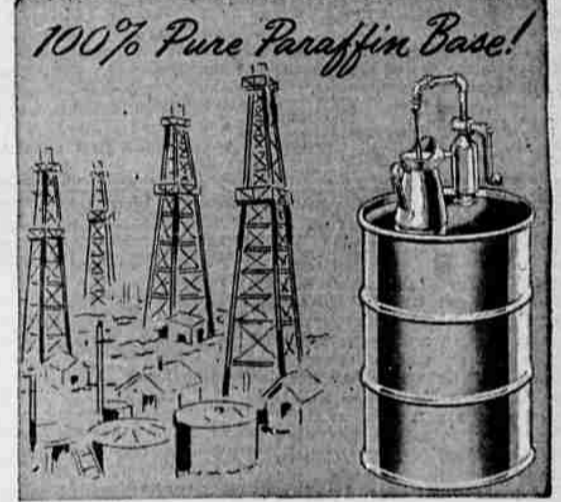
