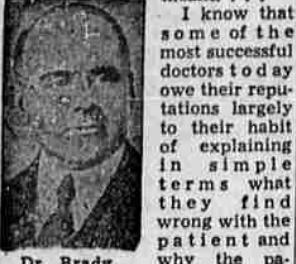

I know that some of the most successful doctors to day owe their reputations largely to their habit of explaining in simple terms what they find wrong with the patient and why the patient should do so and so. I found, in my parlous days of country practice, that if I was too lucid in explaining the situation to the patient or the patient's family I'd lose the case to a competitor who was noted chiefly for what he did NOT tell the patient or the family. People of limited I. Q. took that taciturn attitude my competitor cultivated as evidence of his deep insight and mastery of the situation.

Every tooth you can possibly keep in your jaw is worth a great deal to your health and longevity.

# V.F.W. TO SELL BUDDY POPPIES MAY 25 AND 26

The 24th annual Buddy Poppy sale will be conducted here May 25 and 26 by the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post Commander Robb having appointed Merrill Beneka chairman for the V.F.W., and Mary Debery having been named chairman for the Auxiliary.

A V. F. W. announcement points out that the poppies are strictly a non-profit venture, exclusively for benefit of disabled veterans, their dependents, and the widows and orphans of veterans. The V. F. W. is handling thousands of claims for dependents of men disabled or killed in the present war, Commander Robb emphasized, adding that service is free of charge and regardless of wether the beneficiaries belong to the organization.

The following proclamation was issued by Mayor C. A. Meeker in behalf of the sale: "WHEREAS, the Buddy Poppy has been universally adopted as America's flower of remembrance ever since the annual nationwide sale of this symbolic flower was inaugurated by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States in 1922 and

"WHEREAS, the purpose of this nationwide campaign to raise funds are dedicated exclusively to the care and rehabilitation of the nation's disabled and needy veterans, their dependents and the widows and orphans of America's deceased veterans and

"WHEREAS, this worthy campaign has annually received the approval and endorsement of every President of the United States since 1923, therefore

"BE IT RESOLVED, that the 25th and 26th days of May, 1945, are hereby designated as "Buddy Poppy Days" in the City of Medford and that the patriotic citizens of this community are hereby urged to be generous in their purchases of Buddy Poppies to be worn on Memorial Day by everyone as evidence of our desire to honor the memory of America's hero dead by helping the living."
