VANDERPOOL RELEASED FROM GERMAN PRISON

Pfc. Charles Vanderpool, prisoner of the Germans at a camp near Brodenburg since Dec. 16, has been released and is now in a hospital in France. A letter from the young man, taken prisoner during the "battle of the bulge" was received this week by his mother, Mrs. Mabel E. Vanderpool, R. 1, Box 81, who had not heard from the young man since his imprisonment.

Pfc. Vanderpool said he was being treated for an injured foot and was "trying to get his stomach back in order after living on German banquets of grass soup and ersatz tea." He added that the men in his camp would have starved except for the food in Red Cross packages.

San Bernardino, Cal., June 1.—(U.P.)—Sheriff's deputies today sought to learn the identity of a woman whose half-nude body was found in a shallow desert grave along the Colorado River banks near Earp, Cal. Officers said the woman had been murdered possibly a month ago. The victim was described as between 40 and 50 years of age.
