Your Health and It's Care

WHY SUPERSTITIONS THRIVE
In an essay on Superstitions submitted for our school paper (writes a Canadian reader) I maintain that changes of weather, rain or snow, dry or wet, have little to do with infections of the respiratory tract, and so one of the most odious superstitions is harbored by even educated men - clergymen, doctors of philosophy, masters of art and science and doctors of medicine.

Dr. Brady
Such a man walks into the classroom and says, "Close that window, boy, I don't want you lads catching cold" or the clergyman cautions people that "The wind is so cold and raw, I fear you will catch cold."

First my composition teacher, then the superintendent of schools objected that this portion of my essay was not scientifically true. I cited articles of yours on Prevention of Pneumonia and the little lesson "Call it Cr." The judge dismissed your theories as inconsequential.

Some of the teachers cackled that your newspaper column is mainly an old ladies' gossip column. They concluded that you will have to change your opinion to accord with scientific investigations.

I asked what scientific investigations, and they told me it had been proved recently at McGill that people catch cold more quickly in a draft than not in a draft, that after all there are always some microbes in the system or in the nose or throat, and slight chilling of the body in a draft lowers resistance.

Sir, what am I, a student who is "weak," who gets low marks, to do against men with degrees. (L. Q.)

You and I are disqualified at the barrier, Lauren - our theories, concepts, notions or beliefs are not scientific, whereas those of the old timers are scientific.

That the experiments conducted at McGill proved anything as opposed to the experience of polar explorers, soldiers in foxholes in this war and in the trenches in the first World War, and countless hunters, fishermen, woodsmen, surveyors, sailors, and other folk who know what exposure to cold, wet and sudden and extreme changes of weather means, is silly, I should say.

It will have no weight with the old fossils, but if anybody cares to know I say that so far as I have learned there is no evidence to support the notion that "resistance," whatever that may mean, is adversely affected by change of weather, dampness, draft, etc. It revolves upon any one who argues to the contrary to define what he or she means by "resistance" so that we may know what he or she is talking about.

As for immunity against respiratory infections, certainly

there is no scientific, statistical or empirical evidence that cold, dampness, drafts or sudden change of weather lowers any immunity one happens to have against any known respiratory infection, be it pneumonia, diphtheria or measles.

CRYSTALIDIA
Son, 14, born with one testicle undescended. At age 6 he received injections without apparent result, but since then developed hernia. At 13 he had more injections, again without apparent benefit. (R. K.)

Answer - If one testicle is normal there need be no anxiety as to the development of virility. If the hypodermic or intra-muscular injections of anterior-pituitary-like hormone, administered for a reasonable period of time, at or before the age of 13, fail to cause the testicle to descend into scrotum, there remains the alternative of surgery or let-alone. In view of the occurrence of hernia, your son should have surgical treatment now. If undescended testicle is allowed to go untreated the youth may have serious trouble in a few years.
