

MUSIC ASSN. TO HOLD CAMPAIGN MONTH EARLIER

The executive committee of the Jackson County Civic Music Association met with Franklyn Smith Civic Concert Service representative, in a luncheon meeting at the Holland Hotel yesterday. Present were Seth M. Bullis, president of the association, the Mesdames M. N. Hogan, John Boyle, Richard Payne, Alex Kuehlthau and Miss Mabel Nansen.

Arrangements were concluded to hold the membership week on October 15, a month earlier than last year.

Cpl. Fichtner praised the work of the Filipino guerillas and told of the fried bananas and chicken served to him and his friends by civilians in the Philippines.

Besides the corporal and his wife, Mr. Fichtner has two sons in the service, Clyde Fichtner, T1/c, who is expected home this week, and Earl Fichtner, the youngest son, who is overseas.

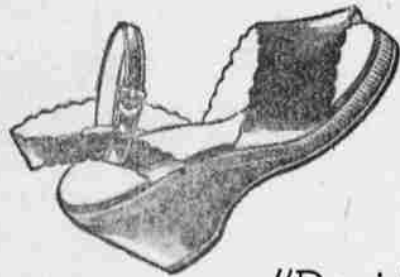

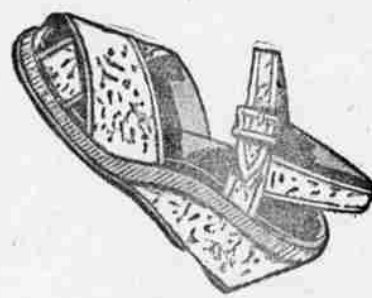
