Fewer Voters on Oregon Registered

Salem, June 21—(U.P.)—There are 42,500 fewer registered voters in Oregon today than there were last fall just prior to the general election, according to county registration figures just compiled by Secretary of State Robert S. Farrell.
Total registrations today stand at 560,536 compared to 602,013 last fall.
The Republican lists show a loss of 19,071—from 302,805 last fall to 283,734 of today.
The Democrats lost 20,482 registered voters, their list dropping from a total of 284,816 last fall to 264,334 today.
Today's registration totals include 2,672 independents, 366 socialists, 478 prohibitionists, and 8,952 listed as "all others."

Federal Officials Recognize Pacific Coast, Kenny Says

Portland, Ore., June 21—(U.P.)—Attorney General Robert Kenny of California today told a West Coast governmental conference that federal officials at last are recognizing that the Pacific coast has special problems.
Kenny endorsed a proposal that California, Oregon and Washington state, county and city officials form an interregional organization to promote cooperation in their mutual problems.
He said the attitude change in Washington, D. C., was expressed by WPB Chairman J. Krug in stating that unemployment would not be a problem except on the Pacific coast, where major war industries will cease but the worker influx is expected to remain.

Disgusted Veteran Attempts Suicide

Seattle, June 21—(U.P.)—Orville Olson, 36, of Bellevue, Wash., in critical condition in King County hospital, told detectives today he shot himself in the abdomen because he was "disgusted."
"I was in the army five months nearly two years ago. When I was called up again—that's when I got disgusted," he said.
He told authorities his wife, Irene, and two children, live in Hollywood.
