I am 28 and I perfectly well. My physician could find no reason, he said, for me not becoming a mother. I sit and my arms ache to hold my own child... we both want a baby madly... we have even considered adopting one, but as we own no property the authorities..."

In the event that the union is not so blessed in that time, it should be clearly understood that conception has not occurred or that if conception has occurred abortion has followed—either accidental or criminal. If conception has not occurred, then (1) the marriage has not been consummated, or (2) the husband is sterile, or (3) the wife is sterile, or (4) both partners are sterile, incapable of procreating, at least for the time being. Sterility, in man or woman, is not necessarily absolute and permanent. When I say a marriage may not prove fruitful until three years I do not mean to imply that it is destined to remain so. It is indeed rare for a couple to be blessed five, 10 or 15 years after marriage.

## German Magnates Planned to Rearm Senator Charges

Washington, June 22.—(U.P.)—Sensational charges were made today that German industrialists have prepared detailed plans to rearm Germany and finance Nazi party underground activities.

The charges, based on hitherto secret documents, were made by Sen. Harley M. Kilgore, D. W. Va., who recently returned from Germany.

Kilgore aimed his accusation principally at leaders in German industrial cartels. "Masquerading as 'neutral' businessmen without political allegiance they have already conceived vicious plans for a third attempt at world conquest," he declared.

### BATAAN AVENGER HURT FOR THIRD TIME ON LUZON

With the 38th Division in Luzon—Pvt. Ray Mann, husband of Mrs. June Mann, of Central Point, Oregon and son of Mr. and Mrs. Joe Mann, of Central Point, has just received the Oak Leaf Cluster to the Purple Heart having been wounded three times in the Luzon campaign.

Pvt. Mann joined the 149th Infantry, a unit of the famed 38th Infantry Division known as the "Avengers of Bataan," shortly after the second invasion of Luzon, and just before the triumphant march down the Bataan peninsula avenging the Death March of 1942.

Pvt. Mann, a rifleman, has recovered from his wounds and returned to his company for duty.

Mann entered the army July 14, 1942, at Medford, Ore. and embarked for overseas service Dec. 13, 1944, and landed with a replacement detachment for the 38th Division on Luzon.

Prior to induction in the army Pvt. Mann was employed by the Skeeter Logging Co. at Medford. He is entitled to wear in addition to the Purple Heart and Oak Leaf Cluster, the Asiatic Pacific Ribbon with one bronze battle star, the Philippine Liberation Ribbon, and the Combat Infantry badge.

**Lt. Col. Charles Thomas**  
HQ, 41st Division, Philippines—Lt. Col. Charles M. Thomas, of Medford, a member of the general staff of the famed 41st Infantry Division, has been awarded the Oak Leaf Cluster to a previously won Bronze Star Medal for conspicuous achievements on the field of battle.

Thomas graduated from Medford high school in 1930 and took a law degree from the University of Oregon.

**Pvt. Lee Bumgardner**  
With U. S. Forces in France—Private Lee H. Bumgardner, whose wife, Fern L., lives in Medford, Oregon, was awarded a Silver Star Medal for outstanding gallantry in action.

The former Fourth Air Force record of 33,500 hours was set by March Field, California, but eclipsed by Tonopah's airmen on April 4th of this year.

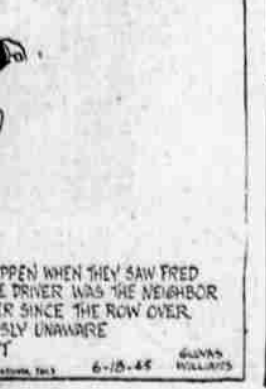
