

PROCLAMATION WHEREAS, the unregulated use of certain forest areas is in my judgment, a menace to life and property due to excessive amounts of dry grass and inflammable debris left on the ground by logging operations, and fires in past years, and

WHEREAS, upon the showing of the State Forester, it appears to me to be necessary to close to unregulated use the following areas designated as:

AREA NO. 31-P—SOUTH-WEST OREGON AREA No. 1—Jenny Creek:

Starting at the junction of Jenny Creek and the California line, running northerly up Jenny Creek to the N.E. corner of Sec. 4, T. 39 S., R. 4 E.; thence northwesterly along road to intersection with south line of Sec. 29, T. 38 S., R. 4 E.; thence west to N.W. corner of Sec. 32, T. 38 S., R. 3 E.; thence north to N.E. corner of Sec. 7, T. 38 S., R. 3 E.; thence west one mile; thence north on range line to intersection with the South Fork of Little Butte Creek; thence westerly down Little Butte Creek to intersection with the north line of Sec. 10, T. 37 S., R. 2 E.; thence west to the N.W. corner of Sec. 7, T. 37 S., R. 2 E.; thence south on range line to the S.W. corner of Sec. 31, T. 38 S., R. 2 E.; thence east 3 miles; thence south to S.W. corner of Sec. 34, T. 39 S., R. 2 E.; thence west 3 miles; thence south on section line to intersection with Colstine Road; thence southerly along Colstine road to California State line; thence east on California line to starting point. All state and county roads and the area immediately surrounding Hyatt Lake will be open.

Permits to enter the above area may be obtained at the following places: State Forest Patrol, Medford; G. E. Miller, Ashland; Lincoln Guard Station, Lincoln.

AREA NO. 32-P—SOUTH-WEST OREGON AREA No. 2—Prospect and Butte Falls:

Starting at the intersection of the South Fork of Little Butte Creek with the west line of Sec. 18, T. 37 S., R. 3 E.; thence northerly on the Forest Service boundary to the center of the east line of Sec. 16, T. 35 S., R. 3 E.; thence north on the section line to the intersection of Prospect and Butte Falls Road on the east line of Sec. 21, T. 34 S., R. 3 E.; thence northerly on the road to the intersection of the south line of Sec. 34, T. 33 S., R. 3 E.; thence east on the township line to the SE corner of Sec. 36, T. 33 S., R. 3 E.; thence north on the range line to the NE corner of Sec. 13, T. 32 S., R. 3 E.; thence north and west on the Forest Service boundary to the intersection on the Mill Creek and north line of Sec. 4, T. 32 S., R. 3 E.; thence south down Mill Creek to center of the west line of Sec. 25, T. 32 S., R. 2 E.; thence north one-half mile to the NE corner of Sec. 25, T. 32 S., R. 2 E.; thence westerly along the Forest Service boundary to the NW corner of Sec. 33, T. 32 S., R. 2 E.; thence in a southwesterly direction on top of the ridge over Burnt Peak and Tatouthe Peak to the intersection with the Crater Lake Highway in Sec. 32, T. 33 S., R. 1 E.; thence northerly along the Crater Lake Highway to the intersection of the east line of Sec. 9, T. 33 S., R. 2 E.; thence south on the section line to the Rogue River; thence down Rogue River to the intersection of Laurel Hurst Road; thence westerly down Laurel Hurst Road to the intersection of the range line common to Rs. 1 and 2; thence south on range line to the intersection of the South Fork of Little Butte Creek Road; thence southeasterly along the road to the point of beginning.

Permits to enter the above area may be obtained at the following places: State Fire Patrol, Medford; Butte Falls Guard Station, Butte Falls; McLeod Guard Station, McLeod.

AREA NO. 33-P—SOUTH-WEST OREGON AREA No. 3—Evans Creek—Trail Creek:

Starting at Trail, Oregon, in the NW corner of Sec. 3, T. 34 S., R. 1 W.; thence northerly up Trail Creek to intersection of the north line of Sec. 4, T. 33 S., R. 1 W.; thence east on township line to the NW corner of Sec. 2, T. 33 S., R. 2 W.; thence following the Cow Creek-Evans Creek Divide westerly to the NW corner of Sec. 18, T. 33 S., R. 4 W.; thence south on county line to the SE corner of Sec. 31, T. 34 S., R. 4 W.; thence east on township line to the intersection with Pleasant Creek Road on the SE corner of Sec. 35, T. 34 S., R. 4 W.; thence southerly along Pleasant Creek Road to junction of road at Wimer; thence northeasterly along Evans Creek Road to junction of East Fork and West Fork of Evans Creek road; thence easterly along east fork of Evans Creek Road to junction of East Fork of Evans Creek Road and Beagle Road in Sec. 20, T. 34 S., R. 2 W.; thence south on Beagle Road to intersection of the south line of Sec. 20, T. 34 S., R. 2 W.; thence east on the section line to the SE corner of Sec. 19, T. 34 S., R. 1 W.; thence north on section line to the NE corner of Sec. 6, T. 34 S., R. 1 W.; thence east to the point of beginning.

Permits to enter the above area may be obtained at the following places: State Forest Patrol, Medford; State Forest Patrol, Grants Pass; Wm. H. Moore, Wimer; Salt Creek Guard Station, West Fork Evans Creek.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HOWARD C. BELTON, Governor of the State of Oregon, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of Section 107-210, Oregon Compiled Laws

Annotated, as amended by Chapter 252, Oregon Laws, 1945, do hereby proclaim the unregulated use of the above described areas to be unlawful and that said areas shall be subject to entry only through permit to be issued by the State Forester, or a fire warden, under which permit entrant shall comply with any and all of the following requirements:

(1) To refrain from smoking except in places designated as safe in said permit.

(2) To build no open fires except in places designated as safe in said permit.

(3) To have as a part of his or her equipment when using campfires, except when traveling as a pedestrian and/or camping at improved, designated and posted campgrounds, tools as specified by the forester suitable for extinguishing fires.

This proclamation shall be effective from and after the 11th day of July, 1945, and shall remain in full force and effect until the 31st day of December, 1945.

Done at the Capitol in Salem, Oregon, this 9th day of July, 1945. HOWARD C. BELTON, Governor

Childbirth Disease Battle is Plea Of University Prexy

Chicago — (U.P.) — Robert M. Hutchins, president of the University of Chicago, has made a plea for a continued fight on childbirth diseases that attack five per cent of all mothers and take the lives of at least 2,000 a year.

Hutchins said puerperal fever and toxemia are the "two great curses" of childbirth. Four or five out of every 100 mothers still develop it, despite modern methods of asepsis, he said. "Neither the cause nor the cure of toxemia is known, and each year more than 100,000 pregnant women have the disease, 20,000 of whom have the particularly dreadful form, eclampsia, which produces convulsions," Hutchins said.

"Research on puerperal fever that I chided the doctor in the instance mentioned. The patient sought to pay a nominal fee for each office visit — as it were — and argued that he could go to the hospital (as a charity patient, of course) and have an operation for less than the doctor charged for the entire treatment. So the doctor properly refused to treat him."

In a similar instance some time ago a reader vehemently charged that a physician I had recommended as skilled in the modern treatment of infected tonsils was a quack who deserved expulsion from the medical profession etc. I happened to know this physician, have long regarded him as the ideal physician and on several occasions have been fortunate enough to obtain his professional service for members of my own family. So I nailed him and learned, as I might have anticipated, that the reader demanded a guarantee that the treatment would cure him or give satisfactory results. Of course no honest physician, specialist or surgeon can or does guarantee anything in any circumstance. If a doctor guarantees cure or satisfactory results or pretends to do so, you may be sure he is a quack and a dangerous one to have any truck with. By any reasonable, informed

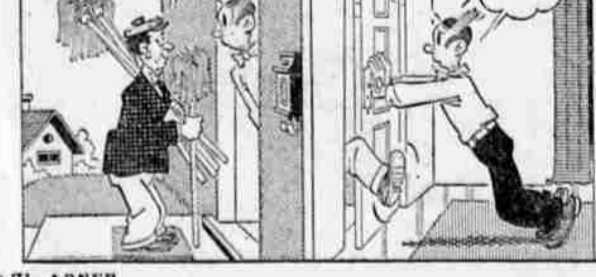
