HOW TO KEEP YOUR FAMILY TOGETHER

Although I may learn of an occasional hospital or maternity institution where the husband is permitted to remain with his wife during delivery, I cannot undertake to name such places for correspondents. Nor shall I name physicians who share my views about this.



Dr. Brady The right way to arrange for the prospective father to remain with his wife as a real man should do, of course, is by stipulating to that when you engage the physician.

Of course, if you are in earnest about establishing a family, you will engage your physician, both of you, as soon as you are reasonably certain you are going to have a baby.

You will go together to engage the physician. And from then on, if you are serious in the desire to make your partnership a permanent, successful and happy one, you will make everything fifty-fifty.

A prospective father is not a man but a mouse if he blithely goes his way and leaves the prospective mother to do all the worrying, studying and preparing alone—as though she were a widow in fact.

If a man is a man he will attend as regularly and as attentively given the advice and instruction given by the physician as his wife does, and he will have as much concern as she has about carrying out the physician's instructions.

Whatever pamphlets or books the prospective mother may read or study in preparing for maternity, the prospective father will of course study too. There is no detail of embryology, prenatal growth and development, pregnancy, childbirth or involution (return to ordinary bodily condition after childbirth) which a man should not understand as well as his wife does.

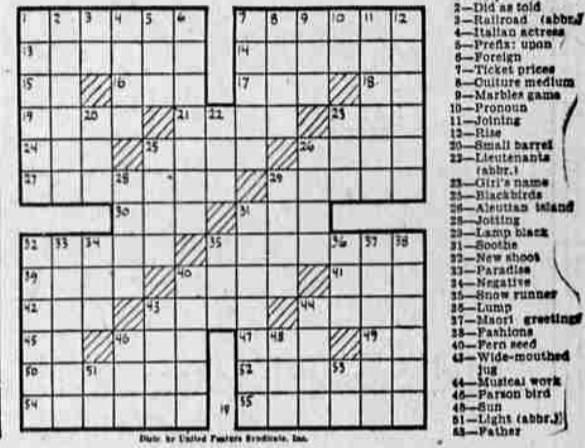
