3 Men Injured In Rogue River Crash

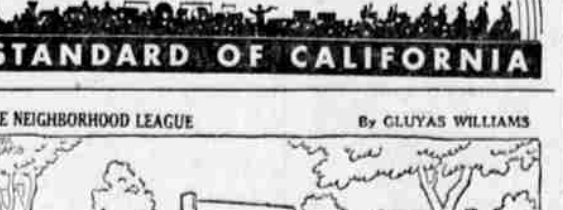
