

TEXAS GULF AREA STORM BLOWS OUT

Houston, Tex., Aug. 29.—(U.P.)—Residents of the stricken Gulf Coast returned to their homes today to view the havoc wrought by a tropical hurricane which destroyed millions of dollars worth of crops and property before blowing itself out in eastern Texas.

The hurricane, one of the worst to hit Texas in 20 years, died yesterday almost as quickly as it began, leaving in its wake a toll of eight known dead. The storm, accompanied by winds of 135 miles an hour at its height, narrowly missed Houston, Texas' largest city.

Your Health and It's Care

DO YOUR TEETH NEED CLEANING? Officer in the Dental Corps of the Army writes: I remember when you decided to call us "dentors"—and then you changed your mind. So your mind can't be completely closed.



Dr. Brady that trademark, I never addressed a dentist by that title. But go on—your comments are worth printing, Doctor:

In my five years of practice of dentistry as a civilian and three years of service in the Army I have made these observations:

- 1. Some people get along well without brushing their teeth.
2. Caries is not caused by uncleanliness alone—witness clean but carious mouths and some filthy non-carious ones.
3. Much periodontal disease in young men in the army and in civilian life is caused by lack of hygiene of the mouth.
4. Periodontal disease (disease of gums) may be arrested by scaling the teeth, but will recur unless proper toothbrushing is instituted.
5. Proper tooth brushing, without any other treatment, will often cause distinct improvement in the condition of the gums.

Naturally I realize that many forms of periodontal disease are caused by traumatic occlusion, faulty nutrition, systemic diseases, blood dyscrasias, endocrine disturbances and poorly fitting dental restorations...

May I suggest that you could do more good by describing a good method of toothbrushing than by your present attitude. I do not believe anyone who brushes his teeth will stop because of your teachings. The worst I can imagine is that your teachings may discourage some children from forming the habit.

Don't brush your teeth, though. You probably don't need it. If I stop for one day I can tell the difference in the tone of my gums. (Signed.....)

Brushing the teeth as much as you wish is quite harmless so far as I know. Correct me if I'm wrong, Doctor. It is my understanding that tartar accumulations on the teeth demand removal by the
