

## CRUELITIES JAPS INFLECTED UPON PRISONERS TOLD

Aboard the Hospital Ship Benevolence, Tokyo Bay, Sept. 1.—At least 23,000 of the 30,000 American troops in the far east at the outbreak of war have died, many of them in prison camps where bodies were cremated on spits and Japanese doctors conducted sadistic "medical experiments," two American doctors reported today.

The doctors, liberated from camps near Tokyo by American occupation troops, were Dr. Mack Leonard Gottlieb, New

York City, captured on Guam in December, 1941, and Dr. Harold W. Keschner, New York City, captured on Bataan.

They listed the following among the many cruelties inflicted on allied prisoners:

1. Failing to treat allied fliers as regular prisoners and subjecting them to such tortures as jabbing splinters under their fingernails in a fruitless effort to get military information.

2. Pouring small amounts of incense-like powder into open wounds and then setting it afire, leaving the victims horribly disfigured.

3. Injecting mixtures of bile drained from gall bladders and acid into tubercular patients in an experiment to find a cure for tuberculosis.

4. Subjecting prisoners to endless mental torture, such as repeating the phrase "very soon all of you will be in a small box"—referring to the Japanese practice of cremating the dead and putting the ashes in a small box.

5. Cremating the bodies of allied prisoners on spits over open fires.

Gottlieb, who spent almost the entire war in prison camps, estimated that not more than 7,000 men were alive of the 30,000 who comprised the U. S. army forces of the far east at the start of the war. Although many of those men died on Bataan and other battlefields, he estimated that "thousands" of others died in prison camps.

## BURNS OIL WELL DRILLING BEGUN

## WORKERS CHARGE 'BUCK PASSED' IN CIO-AFL DISPUTE

Springfield, Ore., Sept. 1.—(U.P.) A second strike by AFL sympathizers was predicted today by two workers involved in the original walkout at the Springfield Plywood corporation.

Control of the company which holds a CIO contract was turned back to the plant by the army Thursday. The problem of the two workers who refused to pay CIO dues was also given back to the union and the Plywood Manufacturing association.

In a joint statement, the two workers said that "with nothing but another strike as a future prospect, for the sake of enabling our organization (AFL) to continue work, and to aid re-conversion and save an unreasonable amount of strife" they would quit their jobs. They charged that the army settlement was a matter of buck passing and that "this left no chance for justice to be rendered, since the joint committee represented the very same agency that discharged us in the beginning."

## PLANE TAKEN AT EUGENE CRASHES

Portland, Ore., Sept. 1.—(U.P.) Military authorities today were investigating the crash of an L-5 Stinson army reconnaissance plane stolen from the Eugene airport.

Portland army air base officials said the plane had been assigned to Eugene for fire patrol duty. It was stolen at 3:30 this morning and a half hour later crashed and burned a few miles of Creswell. None of the occupants have been found.

A marine, Pfc. Lloyd Kenneth Ingram, 21, San Francisco, Cal., is in a Eugene hospital suffering severe burns which he said he sustained when attempting to rescue the occupants.
