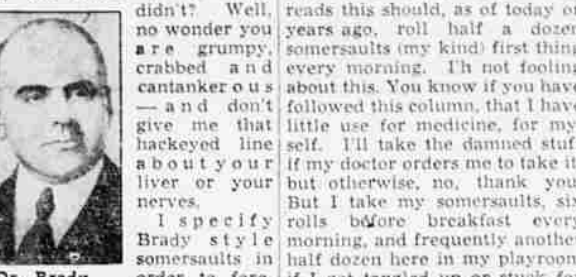

JAP GARRISON AT WAKE SURRENDERS

Guam, Sept. 6—(UP)—Wake island was back under the Stars and Stripes today and the last 139,000 Japanese in New Guinea, New Britain, New Ireland and the Solomon will surrender tomorrow.

It was at Wake, 2000 miles west of Manila that 385 American marines made an epic 14-day stand against the Japanese at the outbreak of the Pacific war.

Seventy-five American marines and seamen from Destroyer Escort Levy Greer and Leahard went ashore on Wake yesterday to avenge that defeat. They ran up the American flag at 1:50 p. m. (Wake time) while the Japanese commander and his staff stood at attention and saluted.
