

U. S. National Bank Shareholders Okeh Stock Boost Plan

A recent special meeting of the shareholders of the United States National Bank of Portland resulted in action to confirm an earlier proposal by the Board of Directors of that institution to increase the bank's capital stock. Announcement of this effect was made by E. C. Sammons, President, immediately after the meeting. The news is of substantial locality because of the interest of the National branch of the United States National maintained at Medford.

The shareholders' action will bring about an increase in the bank's capital stock from \$6,000,000 to \$8,000,000 and an increase in surplus from \$8,000,000 to \$10,000,000. These changes will provide the bank with a paid-up capital and surplus of \$18,000,000 and undivided profits of approximately \$4,750,000.
