Wright Home—Following an honorable discharge from the army at McCaw general hospital, Walla Walla, Wash., Delmer L. Wright arrived Tuesday at the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ray E. Wright, 60 North Orange street. As a technical sergeant, Wright served two years overseas with a ground crew of the 13th air force and was in the army three and one-half years.
