

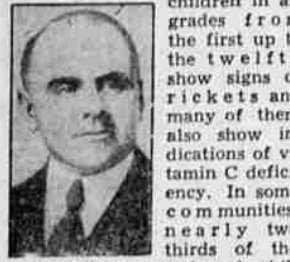

EVERYBODY NEEDS A GOOD BREAKFAST

More than half of the school children in many rural and urban communities in Florida, wrinkles at the corners of the mouth.



Follicular conjunctivitis is a redness and irritation of the lining of the lower eyelids particularly and perhaps also the covering of eyeballs at either side. The lining of eyelids appears "granulated". There are usually considerable itching, burning, photophobia (fear of or dislike of bright light) and a sensation as tho there were sand or cinders in the eyes.

These are the typical manifestations of riboflavin (vitamin B2) deficiency, but probably in every instance there are deficiencies of other B-complex vitamins as well, since riboflavin never occurs in any food without the other vitamins of the B-complex. So far prevention of cure of angular stomatitis (sometimes called cheilosis or cheilitis, which means abnormal or sore condition of lips) and/or prevention and cure of "granulated eyelids" (not to be confused with the red sore eyes of the contagious trachoma), increased intake of the entire vitamin B-complex as this group of vitamins naturally grows in foods such as wheat, beef or calf liver, green leafy vegetables, green or dried peas, milk, eggs, oatmeal or oaten grits, is always preferable to pure riboflavin or pure thiamine (B1).

The skimpy breakfast so many people take, if they take breakfast at all, and the inadequate breakfast so many school children get if they get breakfast at all, explains the wide prevalence of these generally unrecognized nutritional deficiency diseases or conditions here in America among all classes of people, rich and poor—wiseacre and intelligent.
