THE PHYSIOLOGY OF FEAR

From Raider the wolf in the next block to Dinky the Boston terrier next door, nothing with four feet and a gr-r-r-rh ever disturbed the composure of Tony the Irish Terrier, though likely as not he dragged home after the encounter a piteous wreck of what an hour or two before had been a handsome but insufferably snobbish creature. On the other hand the abject terror the poor fellow suffered all through the Fourth of July—which began, generally, about June 25, so far as noises indicated, had to be seen to be believed. At the first firecracker pop Tony would come tearing into the house and crawl as far under cover as he could, and stay there all day or until peace and quiet returned to the neighborhood.

Fear, fright or terror is an emotion common to man and animals. But anxiety, worry, apprehension or premonition plagues only man, especially civilized man.

It is evident from the magnitude of the quackery and nostrum business in Yankeland that the majority of Americans who boast a high school or college "education" are woefully ignorant of physiology and hygiene.

Both fear and rage, or diluted fear (worry, anxiety) and annoyance or irritation (diluted rage) cause more or less outpouring of adrenin from the adrenal glands into the blood, and adrenin brings out (mobilizes) sugar from the store of glycogen (animal starch) in the liver, the sugar being the fuel required to supply immediate energy. Energy for what? Energy for muscle work, whether in fighting or running away.

Well, suppose culture, refinement, convention, the need to appease or the need to retain good will or patronage or confidence forbids such national reaction. Then you are in a state comparable with an automobile engine racing with clutch released or gear disengaged. If you can't use your muscles in fight or flight, nor even excuse yourself to duck into the next room or go through some vigorous exercises, you must just sit or stand there and take it—or the muscles of your heart and arteries must take it—and that's the physiological explanation of "nervous tension."

Incidentally, this little lesson in physiology should make it clear why some baseball or football fans, but instead, if they want to enjoy life and live long, cultivate some sport, game or pastime in which they can participate themselves—ACTION is what they need to save their arteries, even if it be just playing catch or pitching horseshoes or pushing a little ball around a patch of greensward with a putter—anything but vicarious excitement or make-believe.

Terpin Hydrate
In an article on winter cough you mentioned capsules of terpin hydrate. What do these capsules contain? Are they harmless? (M. T. G.)

Answer—Terpin hydrate is a crystalline derivative of oil of turpentine. Two grains in capsule twice a day after food is harmless to take as an expectorant in chronic bronchitis. One or two or three drops of pure oil of turpentine (not crude spirits of turpentine used by painters) on a little sugar or in a capsule, twice daily after food, will give the same relief for chronic winter cough.
