

U. S. STILL MAKING ATOMIC BOMBS TO EXPERIMENT WITH

President Says Full Membership of UNO Should Have Part in Commission

Washington, Nov. 21—(AP)—President Truman told his news conference today that the United States is still manufacturing atomic bombs. He said they are being made for experimental purposes.

At the same time the President said he thought the full membership of the United Nations organization should have a part in establishing the atomic energy commission which was proposed here last week by the President and Prime Ministers Attlee of Great Britain and W. L. Mackenzie King of Canada.

Peace Use Is Hope
One of the first things on the program of the United States when United Nations organizations sessions begin in London, the President said, will be to ask for the formation of the atomic commission.

The President reiterated his hope that the program outlined by the three atomic powers would lead to the employment of atomic energy for peace instead of war.

One way to do this, he said,

would be to use for industrial development the same material that is now going into experimental bombs.

This, however, he added, would take a long time to accomplish and could come about only after much more scientific research.

A question about the prospects for an early meeting of the Big Three brought from the President a completely negative reply: He knew of no such plans.

Not Pessimistic
Asked for comment on the strife still plaguing many parts of the world, Mr. Truman said he was not in the slightest bit pessimistic about prospects for enduring peace. He added that the atomic energy talks here constituted a first step toward implementing the UNO with action.

He said he thought every country in the world was now preoccupied with domestic problems and not paying as much attention as it will later to international affairs.

The President reiterated belief that the world is on the threshold of its greatest era and that unless this era is approached in mutual confidence and permanent peace, the nation faces an alternative of renewed destruction.

RECEIVERS NAMED FOR GOLDEN RULE CHURCH PROPERTY

Los Angeles, Nov. 21—(AP)—Three federally appointed receivers today took over the \$4,000,000 empire of Arthur "The Voice" Bell's Christ Church of the Golden Rule.

Federal Judge William C. Mathes yesterday appointed as joint receivers Attorney J. Ray Files, Stewart McKee, businessman; and Paul W. Sampson, bankruptcy specialist.

Assets of the church, involving property in Imperial Valley and as far as Jackson and Josephine counties in Oregon, have been the subject of a dispute as to whether state or federal courts should have jurisdiction. The state seized a number of buildings before the church filed a petition of bankruptcy in federal court last week.

The state attorney-general's office plans to continue action aimed at dissolution of the church on grounds it is improperly incorporated under state statutes. The federal court ordered State Receiver R. E. Allen to turn over church properties and Benne Brink was appointed as federal referee to supervise bankruptcy affairs.
