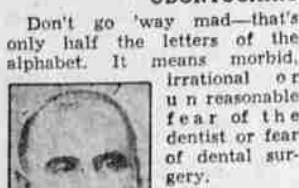


# Your Health and It's Care

Don't go "way mad"—that's only half the letters of the alphabet. It means morbid, irrational or unreasonable fear of the dentist or fear of dental surgery.

"I am a very nervous person," writes a reader, "and have a dread of going to the dentist. Every time I make an appointment I can't think of anything else and get so scared and upset over it that I just can't keep the appointment. I have your booklet No. 15 but it doesn't help me any. What can you recommend to enable me to have the dental treatment I need?"

For a first visit to the dentist have it understood that you are coming for examination only or perhaps for what the dentist calls prophylaxis—cleaning, scaling, polishing—which is comparable to having your nails manicured or your hair dressed, so far as discomfort is concerned.

Not that I am not as fond of comfort as any one nor that I can endure when there is any possible and reasonably safe way to avoid it. But I have learned to contemplate an appointment with the dentist with a good deal of satisfaction, because I want to keep fit and live as long as I can, and I know, if I know anything about how to keep well, that whatever treatment the dentist may give me will help me to keep well and live long. I feel that way even though I expect the treatment may hurt some.

The reader's panic over a visit to her dentist is clearly a phobia, a morbid, irrational, unreasonable dread or fear. Per-

haps it is based on some painful experience the reader herself had with a crude dentist when she was a child, or on the highly colored reports of other people who have fallen into the clutches of dental quacks.

If the treatment or surgery is likely to be at all painful the dentist today can use local anesthetics and carry out the treatment or operation quite painlessly, and safely too.

If the patient is obsessed with that twenty-one letter trouble which I have been at great pains to spell out above, the family physician can give the patient a dose or two or one of the barbiturates (I shall not tell you which one) before the patient visits the dentist, and this will take the terror out of the scene. Or if the dentist is really qualified to call himself Doctor there is no good reason why he should not give his patient this preliminary sedative when the patient dreads the treatment of operation like that.

**QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**  
**Systolic Heart Murmur**  
Please explain what "Systolic heart murmur of the apex" is and give the symptoms and seriousness of this ailment. (L. B.)  
Answer—Murmur is a sound heard over the heart or blood vessels, and it has no specific significance. Systolic means the contraction or beating of the heart. Apex means the tip or point of the heart in the lower part of the left chest, the base of the heart being in the upper part of the chest. If you quote something you read, better leave such reading to the doctor. If you quote what some doctor said, better quote doctors.
