

**WAR PREVENTION
ONLY SAFEGUARD
AGAINST A-BOMB**

Atomic Power Exerts, Social Science Workers and Educators Support Proposal.

Denver, Dec. 11—(U.P.)—Atomic power experts, social science workers and educators, supporting the Truman-Attlee-King proposal for a commission to control atomic energy, agreed today that only prevention of war could save the world from destruction.

At the conclusion of an atomic power conference at Denver university, atomic scientists and laymen declared that international control of the new weapon was the only way to save the world from an atomic death.

Dark Future In War
A group of more than 20 scientists who took part in the atomic research project ended a three-day conference with sociology and education experts yesterday. Their findings indicated a dark future if war was again to ravage the world, but a bright future if common sense and understanding was to rule.

Heading a list of recommendations agreed upon at the end of the meetings was the establishment of an international commission for control of atomic energy, as proposed by President Truman and Prime Ministers King and Attlee.

Scientists said the "secret of the atomic bomb" was short-lived. Dr. Joyce C. Stearns, Washington university professor who aided in the atomic research, estimated that it would take only from three to five years for any nation to discover the so-called secret.

No Atom Defense
The scientists and educators could offer no assurance for safety of civilization in the years to come except by the total disappearance of war.

"If wars are permitted to occur, the atomic bomb will be used. Lacking a world organization, it cannot be outlawed or controlled by national legislation," the scientists said.

"There is no active military defense against the atomic bomb. The most practical defense is simply that of avoiding wars."

The physicists, who came to the conference from laboratories at Los Alamos, N. M., and Oak Ridge, Tenn., as well as several universities, recommended an "inspection force" as part of the United Nations organization.

Inspection Needed
The UNO inspectors would make periodic inspections of factories and laboratories of all nations. To do this, there must be complete confidence and mutual desire for peace among nations, they said.

Scientists attending the conference were conservative in their estimates of possible world-shaking uses of atomic power, but hinted that further research, which they insisted be on a free, international scale, would open the door to vast medical, industrial and agricultural developments.

Find Four Dead After Rum Bout

Los Angeles, Dec. 11—(U.P.)—Three sailors and an unidentified woman were dead today, victims of asphyxiation after what police described as a drinking party in an auto court.

The dead, all found last night dressed only in underwear in an auto cabin, the Dare-U-In, were identified as Thomas P. McCasland, 21, S1/c; Floyd W. Schnetzer, 22, S2/c; Harry R. Lowery, 21, T3/c, and a blonde woman, about 30 years old but unidentified.

Authorities today were attempting to identify the woman.

Japan's Farmers To Be Emancipated

Tokyo, Dec. 11—(U.P.)—Emancipation of the Japanese farmer was ordered today in a directive issued by Gen. Douglas MacArthur calling for abolition of the feudal system of land ownership which long has held rural Japan in economic bondage.

The Japanese government was directed to accomplish the agricultural reforms in plans which must be submitted to supreme allied headquarters by March 15, 1946.
