Judge Orders Man To Read Books On Racial Tolerance Hollywood, Jan. 9.—(UP)—Actor C. A. (Michael) Owens, 32, was ordered today by Superior Judge Thomas L. Ambrose to read four books on racial tolerance to escape a jail sentence on his conviction of beating Screen Writer John Wexley.

Owens was accused at his trial recently of attacking Wexley on V-J day following a minor traffic accident, and shouting, "you dirty Jew, I'll kill you."

In granting three years probation in lieu of a six month jail term, Judge Ambrose handed Owens four books to read: "The Falacy of Race," and "Man's Most Dangerous Myth,"
