Little Lesson No. 2, the booklet titled CVD, however instructive or practical it may be, remains one of the less popular booklets in the series.

Well, I'm stuck with it now—it is too late to retrace my steps and try to persuade all present readers that when a doctor uses the term degeneration he means simply a retrogressive change in cells and tissues and nothing else.

Some medical authorities speak of "reversing the process of degeneration" or bringing about regeneration or rejuvenation. I don't know whether we can do that in any circumstance, but I am certain we can arrest the degeneration process or at least retard it.

As it seems to me, decay and loss of teeth, pyorrhea, rheumatism, arteriosclerosis and premature old age are just different manifestations of degeneration, and degeneration depends mainly upon the individual's nutrition—not just while he or she is following a diet or taking treatment but throughout infancy, childhood, youth and adulthood.
