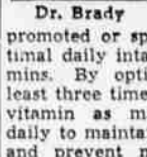

VITAMINS AND ARTHRITIS

There is considerable evidence
to show that shortages of vita-
mins C, B-complex and D may
favor development of one or
another chronic joint trouble
which is called
arthritis or
rheumatism.
There is some
evidence, too,
that relief and
even recovery
from chronic
arthritis or
chronic rheu-
matism may be
promoted or speeded by an op-
timal daily intake of these vita-
mins. By optimal I mean at
least three times as much of the
vitamin as may be required
daily to maintain good nutrition
and prevent manifestations of
deficiency.



Now just how much of each of
these vitamins does the average
adult require daily to maintain
good nutrition and prevent defi-
ciency manifestations (symptoms,
complaints)?
Nutrition authorities agree
that the daily minimum require-
ment of vitamin C (ascorbic acid)
is 30 milligrams. That is the
amount of vitamin C in, say one-
half of a fresh tomato, one-
quarter of a lemon, one-half of
an orange, one ounce of raw cab-
bage, or not less than six ounces
(small glassful) of commercially
canned tomato juice, or 3 1/2
ounces of raw turnip.

ment of vitamin B-complex is
difficult to determine because
the various components (B1 or
thiamine, B2 or riboflavin, niacin
and more particularly described
as follows:
