Radar Opens New Exploration Door Into Solar Space

Washington, Jan. 26—(U.P.)—Army scientists looked confidently ahead today to vast explorations in solar space with radar.

It is now possible, they believe, that radar-controlled space ships some day will ply the airless void between the planets, electronically gathering and transmitting to earth data thus far beyond man's ken.

Army signal corps engineers, it was revealed last night, already have bounded radio pulses of extremely high frequency and energy against the moon and fielded them at the speed of light on instruments at the Evans Signal Laboratory, Belmar, N.J.

EYEBALL PUNCTURING NAZI TORTURE FORM

Nuernberg, Jan. 26—(U.P.)—French Prosecutor Charles Du Bost told the war crimes court today that the puncturing of eyeballs was one of the many forms of Nazi tortures inflicted on patriots of western Europe during the occupation.

Du Bost said uniform torture methods were used throughout the German police system, and the "atrocities sprang from the center of the German government" of which many of the defendants were members.
