A DIET WITHOUT MILK IS INADEQUATE

Speaking of the softness of present day American youth—as indicated by rejection of military of young men examined under the draft—and the delicacy and weakness of growing children, I said the other day that the primary cause of this physical unfitness is nutritional deficiency.



In bulk or weight; and milk is "reducing" only if or when the glass or pint replaces more than its caloric value of other foods in the regular diet.

Answer—But example, neglected education, morbid attitude or point of view, unhealthy environment. Probably your wife and her mother before her had no sound instruction. For your daughter's sake send me a stamped envelope bearing her address and ask for pamphlet Hygiene for Girls and Health for Women—ask in writing. A clipping will not do.

Does toasting bread destroy the vitamins? (Mrs. T. S.)

Answer—What vitamins? Ordinary white bread contains none worth counting. But if there are any vitamins (B-complex, vitamins) in the bread toasting has only slight destructive effect. Practical suggestion—how to get the vitamins you should get but do not get in white bread are given in pamphlet "Wheat to Eat" for copy send stamped addressed envelope and ask for the pamphlet in writing. 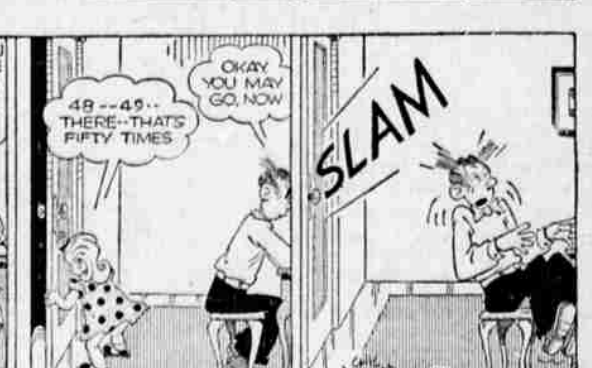
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
