The final turkey shipment of the season was made today by the Blue Moon company of San Francisco. The shipment, consisting of about 4,000 birds, cleans up the local market.

In some sections of the county, turkeys have started to lay but for the most part have been held back by the cold and rains. Some producers are keeping the brood turkeys in warm and lighted coops which increases laying. It is expected general laying will start in another week or ten days.

The turkey crop in Jackson and Josephine counties last season was estimated at around 125,000 birds. It is not expected to be as large the coming year.
