

PHONE COMPANY PROGRAM MEANS HEAVY SPENDING

Pacific Telephone and Telegraph company's expansion program for 1946, now well underway, will require an all-time high expenditure of \$90,000,000 according to N. R. Powley, president, who released the figures with the firm's 1945 annual report to shareholders received today by R. H. Hammond, Medford manager for the company. The five-year program calls for expenditure of \$400,000,000 for construction, the president said.

Although the firm experienced exceptional growth throughout the war years, it did not profit from the war, the president declared, citing the fact that earning per common share in 1939 were \$7.87, whereas in 1945 they declined to \$6.78 and dividends per common share declined from \$7.50 to \$6.50.

Commenting on the war years, Powley declared that in the six years subsequent to Dec. 31, 1939, the firm handled new installations, discontinuances and moves totaling 7,297,029, or almost four times as many telephone calls as it had in service at the beginning of the period.

Total originating calls were more than 4,600,000,000, an increase of more than 290,000,000 calls over 1944," Powley said, "and toll and long distance calls increased 2 per cent. Longer haul calls, destined beyond our territory, increased 52 per cent

over 1944 and 1700 per cent over the year 1939."

"Since pre-Pearl Harbor days, our organization has grown by more than 21,000 people, or 71 per cent. Of this number, over 57 per cent of the men and 67 per cent of the women had had 10 years or more of service."

POLICEMAN SUES SOUTHERN PACIFIC

C. W. Clause, night officer on the city police force, filed a damage suit against the Southern Pacific railroad for \$10,000 general damages and \$2,500 special damages in Circuit court yesterday as the result of an auto-box-car crash on the Sixth street crossing, in the early evening of Feb. 25, 1944.

Clause claims in his complaint that while driving on Sixth street he was crashed into by a box car, suddenly bumped across the street by a locomotive and that no warning of any kind was given. It is further set forth that a Clause sustained six broken ribs, a cut knee and bruises and abrasions as a result of the crash, and that he still suffers.

The plaintiff is represented in the action by Attorneys Ralph E. Moody of Salem and O. H. Bengtson of this city.

New 'Ham & Eggs' Pension Plan For California Voters

Sacramento, Feb. 15.—A new "ham and eggs" pension plan appeared on the Capitol scene today with filing of title for an initiative constitutional amendment designed primarily to give a 30-dollars-every-Thursday pension to persons over 50 years of age or unable to work.

Secretary of State Frank M. Jordan said sponsors of the proposal must obtain 178,764 signatures of registered voters in the next 90 days to qualify the measure for a place on the November election ballot. Proponents of the measure were Willis Allen and Roy G. Owens of Los Angeles, leaders of several previously defeated pension plans.
