

NEW BUILDING FOR WILLYS DEALERS NEAR COMPLETION

The first unit of a \$50,000 construction program for Champion's Sales and Service, new Willys dealers here, is nearing completion and will be scene of the initial showing of Universal Jeeps starting today, according to L. D. Champion. The new structure, ultra modernistic in architecture, is located at 317 East Fifth street and will become part of a building program extending over an area 160 by 135 feet. The repair shops which formerly housed Champ's Garage will be demolished soon and replaced by a modern building, with paved parkways in front.

The display rooms and parts building is of masonry construction with reinforced columns and beams, and curtain walls of cement tile. Wooden roof trusses span 40 feet, topped by built-up roofing. Parapet walls of modernistic design will provide space for neon signs. The building contains a spacious showroom with large plate glass windows, a large parts department and offices.

Associated with L. D. Champion will be his two sons, Elmer and Ralph, recently back from service with the army. Willys cars, trucks and jeeps will be featured along with complete automotive service.

GOLD MINERS AID URGED BY SOLON

Washington, Feb. 16—(U.P.)—Rep. Berkeley Bunker, D. Nev., said today gold miners face a tough battle for survival because of the near-contempt in which easterners hold precious metals.

"One member of congress said on the floor not long ago he would just as soon own a bar of iron as one of gold," Bunker said at the end of miners' testimony on a bill to compensate them for losses suffered when their properties were ordered closed at the start of the war.

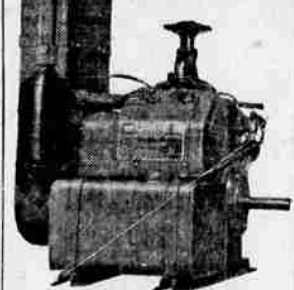
Rep. Clair Engle, D. Calif., chairman of the war claims committee said the bill had been reported unfavorably by both the treasury department and the civilian production administration. Secretary of the Treasury Fred M. Vinson wrote that he did not approve of legislation to benefit one industry for war losses.

"What they overlook," Engle said, "is that no other industry was told bluntly to close up. The others suffered indirect losses, perhaps, but the miners got it right in the teeth."

ROBOT TO SPEED BALLISTIC DATA

Philadelphia, Feb. 16—(U.P.)—A gigantic "mathematical robot" which solves in hours, problems which would take trained mathematicians over 100 years to answer, will be dedicated today by the war department.

The 30-ton machine known as the electronic numerical integrator and computer, almost completely fills a room 30 by 50 feet and contains some 18,000 vacuum tubes in its
