

## CONGRESS QUELLS EXTENSION PLANS OF WHITE HOUSE

Washington, Feb. 22—(U.P.)—Congress has caught the White House with its windows down. This embarrassing situation has to do with the elaborate plans for building an extension to the west wing of the White House. The extension was to have cost \$1,600,000 and the funds had been authorized by congress.

When detailed plans for the extension were announced, however, congress had a change of mind. Senators and representatives did not like the idea of altering the lines of the executive mansion and offices.

**Fixtures Torn Out**  
Meanwhile, the work had been going on. Workmen tore out windows at one end of the west wing. They knocked down a wall and they ripped up old steam pipes. They tore out lighting fixtures.

Lorenzo S. Winslow, the White House architect, released sketches of the plans.

The way Winslow explained things, the addition of such things as an auditorium, television studios and a cafeteria to the west end would cause no publicly visible change in the White House.

**Funds Lacking**  
To see the changes, he said, a person would have to rent a helicopter and get right over the White House.

But congress had a different idea. The house withdrew an appropriation. The senate followed suit. And Winslow was left with no money for the project, no windows in a part of the west wing, and a lot of big clay mounds in the back yard.

Ted Hopkins, U.S. Army (Ret.), who was for several years the Federal inspector-instructor of the Oklahoma National Guard.

## Aluminum Plants Leased to Kaiser

Washington, Feb. 22—(U.P.)—The War Assets Corp. today announced the lease of two government-owned aluminum plants at Spokane, Wash., to the Kaiser-Frazer Corp. and Kaiser Cargo, Inc.

The lease will be subject to the approval of the attorney general.

The \$47,000,000 Trentwood aluminum rolling mills will be leased to the Kaiser-Frazer automobile makers. The Mead aluminum reduction plant which cost the government \$22,000,000 will go to Kaiser Cargo.

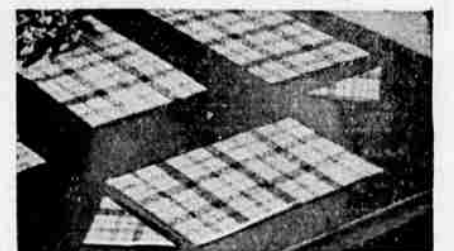
