'Crusade' Seen In Senate Candidacy

Fred E. Robinson, Medford business man who is seeking the republican nomination for United States senator, returned yesterday from Portland with word that his candidacy has started something in the nature of a crusade among those up-state republicans who hope to oust Sen. Wayne Morse.

Lamar Toozee, Portland attorney and Partner of Ralph H. Cake, republican national committeeman, has been pondering the idea of running for the senate but no definite word has yet been given as to his decision. The matter would be somewhat complicated in Toozee's case as his partner, Cake, is a very close friend of Senator Morse.

The 1950 line of Lincolns and Lincoln Cosmopolitan automobiles go on display tomorrow at Medford Motors, Sixth and Ivy streets, it was announced today by Ralph Furrer of the company. Some 150 mechanical improvements and styling changes have been made in the new line of cars, Furrer said. Among these are easier steering, a more efficient handbrake, better oil economy, carburetor improvements which result in finer engine performance, low idling speeds, heavier frames, improved door locks, and "unusual luxury and liveliness combined with the highest standard of comfort and performance."

Styling features include a new front grille with severe modern horizontal lines, newly styled front fenders, and eight new exterior colors. New "union-styled" interiors have been created by the utilization of fine fabrics, foam rubber and other innovations, Lincoln officials say.
