Contest To Help Philippine School Restore Library

For the past three years, the Medford junior high school has aided the Pangasinan provincial high school of Lingayen, Philippine islands, by sending it text-books, magazines and other educational material. This project has had more than ordinary interest for Medford teachers and students since one of Medford's teachers, Miss Ruth Ella Dickerson, at one time taught in the school.

The Pangasinan high school no longer needs help, but another war-devastated Philippine school, the Badian provincial high school of Badian, Cebu, Philippine islands, has asked the junior high school faculty and student body to help replenish its high school library. The idea has been enthusiastically received and a committee of teachers and students has worked out a plan for carrying it into effect.

Will Be Contest

The project will be conducted as a contest between home rooms of the school, the room contributing the most in books or money to be given a treat or special award.

Books donated must be in good condition and suitable for a school library. Money will be used to pay for subscriptions to good magazines or to purchase new books. The cost of transportation from San Francisco will be borne by the Philippine government, so practically all collections will go to the direct aid of the Badian school. It is hoped that parents and other patrons of the school will cooperate with the students of the junior high school in making this worth while project a success.

The contest began Monday, February 6 and will close Friday.

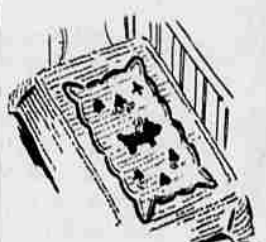
