Judge Tries Free Man He Convicted

Scranton, Pa. (U.P.)—George Hreben, 32, has been exchanging letters since 1939 with the judge who sent him to prison for 30 to 60 years for a series of burglaries while on parole.

During the war, Hreben prayed that Judge T. Linus Hoban, serving in the army, would turn up safely after he was reported missing in action. Judge Hoban did. He returned to his post as president judge of the Lackawanna county court, and recently wrote a letter to the Pennsylvania pardons board.

In it Judge Hoban asked that Hreben be paroled, because, he said, "his correspondence indicates steady, constant intellectual development and... a rather marked degree of moral rehabilitation."

Judge Hoban said he believed the time was ripe for Hreben's parole if he appears to be a safe risk to the penal authorities.

It will be Hreben's fourth try for freedom. He is now blind in one eye and failing sight in the other.

Standard Designed For U. S. Aircraft

San Diego, Cal. (U.P.)—Capt. Clinton E. Smith, former California national guard officer, has designed a flag he hopes will be used by all U. S. aircraft.

Smith says that since congress officially approved an ensign for American yachts, there is no reason why it should not also approve an ensign for aircraft.

The flag he has designed has the regular seven red stripes and six white. In the upper right corner is a white winged-globe on a field of blue, surrounded by 13 white stars.

He hopes to have congress approve the flag as an official U. S. ensign to be painted on all American aircraft, commercial and private alike.

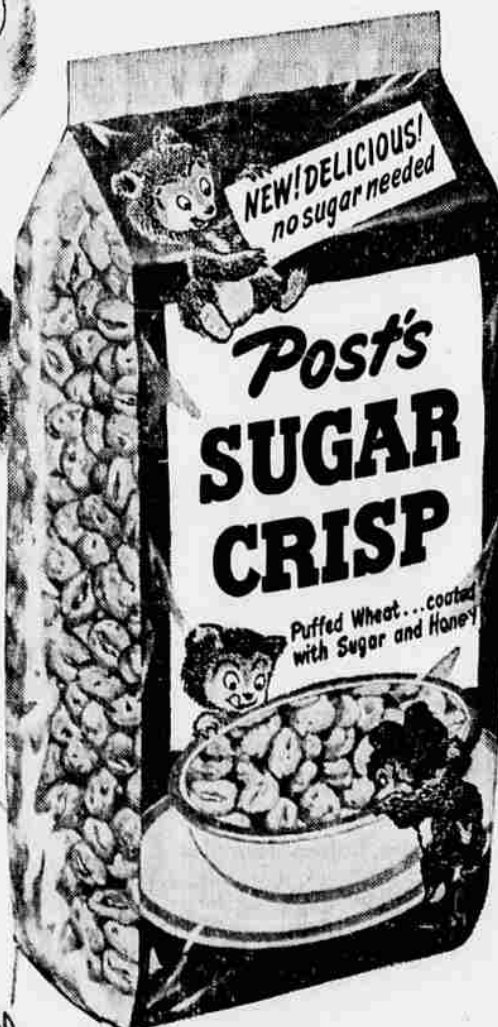

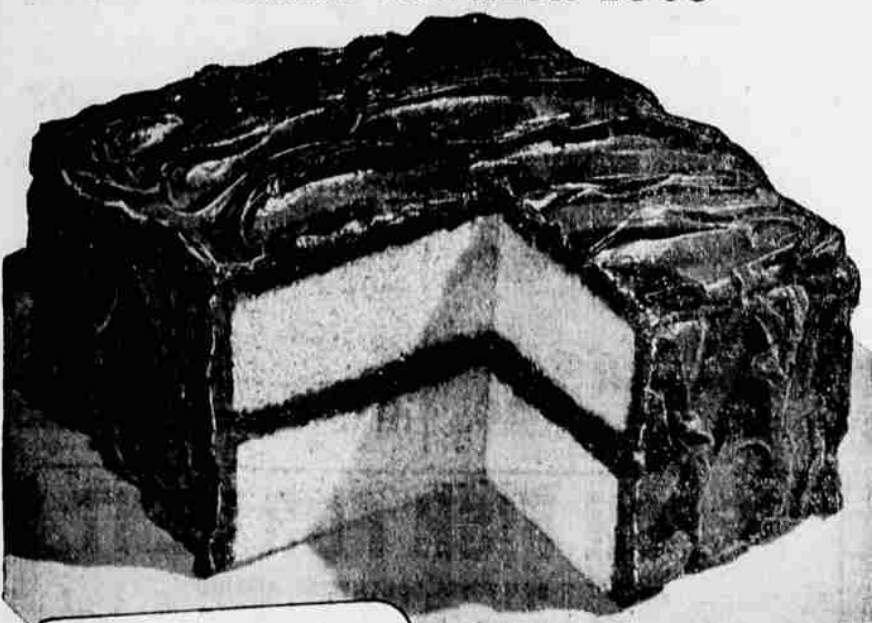

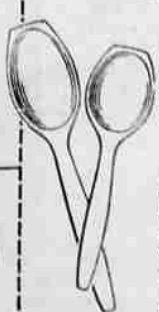
