OBSERVATIONS ON PEPTIC ULCER

Ulcer is a loss of tissue, such as an open sore. A peptic ulcer is an ulcer of either the stomach or the duodenum...

Peptic ulcer seems to be caused by an excess secretion of hydrochloric acid by the lining of the stomach...

We do not know what causes this excess secretion. Several theories have been advanced. There is not enough space available here to discuss them.

A peptic ulcer is either in the stomach or in the duodenum. A combination of both is an extremely rare occurrence...

The term "stomach ulcers" is very indefinite. Folks who use the term should know that the ulcer is invariably single...

The best treatment for cancer of the digestive apparatus is immediate surgical removal. There can be no quibbling or evasion on this point...

An ulcer is primarily a medical problem not surgical. Surgery is used in ulcer only when medical treatment has been thoroughly tried and found ineffective...

In perforation, the ulcer penetrates to the outer covering of the digestive tube, which gives way, allowing the contents of the tube to spill out into the abdominal cavity...

Hemorrhage from an ulcer can usually be handled by medical treatment. However, if a person suffers three severe hemorrhages, he should certainly be a candidate for surgical treatment...

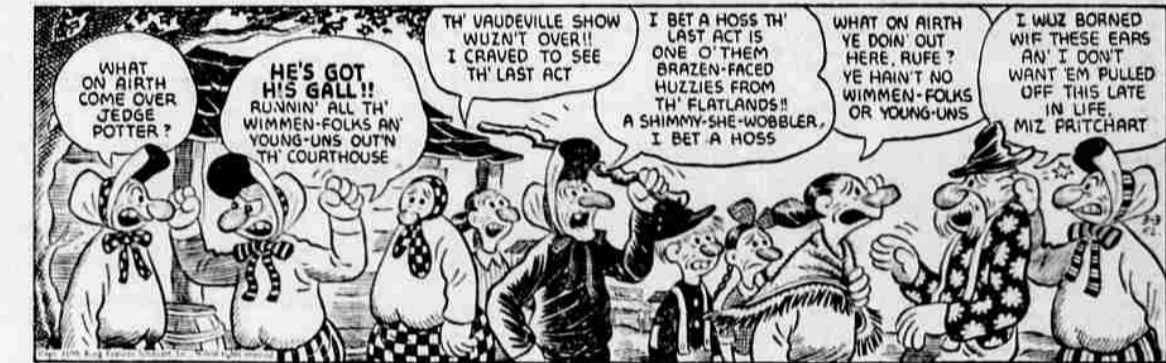
