Dublin, (U.P.)—A tiny sailing boat, converted from a rowboat, crept through the gale-swept seas, almost smashed itself on a line of needle-edged rocks and crawled to the quiet of Wexford harbor.

Its pilot, radio-engineer Paul Muller, aged 63, and his daughter, Aga, both refugees from the Soviet zone of Germany, had reached another step in their desperate flight to South America.

When he saw them near the reef, Capt. Mark Bates of the motor trawler Pride of Helvic called for aid and went to their assistance.

As they approached the tiny Berlin, the trawler skipper signaled to the Mullers to lower their sails. Then they maneuvered close to the Berlin, threw a rope and took it in tow.
