Big Mo Captain Court Trial Is Postponed

Norfolk, Va., March 25—(U.P.)—A navy court martial for Capt. W. D. Brown, who skipped the battleship Missouri when she went aground January 17, has been postponed until March 30.

Proceedings were to have started next Monday. But Atlantic fleet headquarters said Brown's counsel asked the postponement so that "necessary witnesses" might be present.

Two other Missouri officers, Operations Officers Cmdr. John R. Millett and Navigator Lt. Comdr. Frank G. Morris Jr., will be tried on schedule Monday.

They were ordered to courts martial after an official inquiry into the 15-day grounding of the navy's only active battleship.
