

Baldock Favors Cut in Spending On New Highways

Portland, Ore., Apr. 4—(U.P.)—R. H. Baldock, Oregon state highway engineer, wants to cut spending on new highway construction in half and increase work on repairs.

Baldock yesterday said he would soon formally recommend to the state highway commission that about half the \$15,000,000 spent annually on new highway construction be diverted to repair and strengthening of existing highways.

Much Damage Done
The engineer told the commission that much damage had been done to the state's highways during the last two years. He blamed the damage partly on increased trucking resulting from population influx and partly on overloading by some operators.

Cutting new construction funds in half will not mean half as many miles of new construction, but will mean less new road mileage for a given amount of money, Baldock said. He told the commission that along with strengthening old roads, it would be necessary to build new highways stronger than those built in the past.

Crommelin Thinking Of Political Venture

Birmingham, Ala., Apr. 4—(U.P.)—Capt. John G. Crommelin says he has not decided definitely whether to enter Alabama politics.

Crommelin, who was furloughed by the navy as a result of his stand on unification, said that at present he is "discussing the situation and getting information on which to base a decision."

Crommelin is considering running as an independent in the general election this year against Sen. Lister Hill (D., Ala.).

He got interested in the race too late to qualify for the democratic primary of May 2.

"I have some very big personal decisions to make," Crommelin told friends here. "It's complicated also by the fact that I'm on indefinite furlough."

UAL Will Establish Mail Order Tickets

Portland, Ore., Apr. 4—(U.P.)—United Air Lines here announced today it will establish a mail order ticket sales system for patrons in areas remote from ticket offices.

Sales Manager James L. Snell said ticket sales, reservations and information will be mailed to customers from the seven Oregon offices of the line.

UAL has offices in Portland, Salem, The Dalles, Eugene, Medford, Klamath Falls and Bend. The mail order procedure is designed to aid rural and suburban customers, Snell said.
