Industrial Accident Contribution Rates Lowered; Savings of \$1 Million Seen

Salem, Apr. 12—Reductions in employer contribution rates have been announced by the state industrial accident commission effective July 1, 1950. These reductions will apply in 277 industrial and trade classifications of Oregon business.

While practically every portion of the state's economy will benefit from the new employer's contribution rate schedule, the basic industries of general farming and lumbering in its various phases will experience the greatest savings because of the larger payrolls in these two industries. The new employer contribution rate schedules mark the fourth reduction in premium rates since 1943. During the same period the various legislatures have increased workmen's benefit payments under the act four times. While the increase in compensation for workmen is in keeping with the increase in the cost of living, the downward trend in employer contribution rates is more startling by comparison, commission spokesmen said.

Accidents Prevented—In all of the classifications where hazards have generally been high, the reductions have been accomplished because of the same period the various legislatures have increased workmen's benefit payments under the act four times. While the increase in compensation for workmen is in keeping with the increase in the cost of living, the downward trend in employer contribution rates is more startling by comparison, commission spokesmen said.

Under the experience rating provision of the Oregon law all employers under the act can qualify for from 10 per cent to 50 per cent reduction from the base rates established after one calendar year of favorable accident experience.
