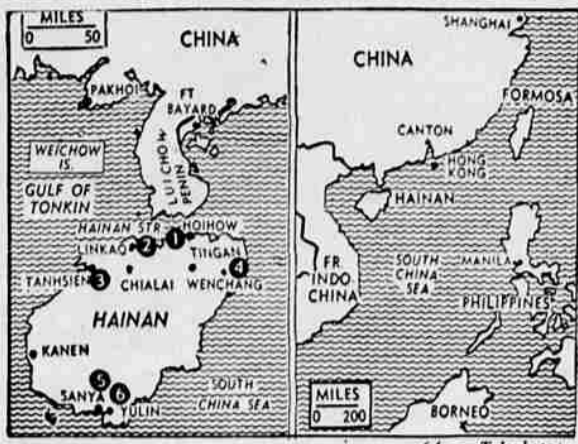

### Decorators Offer Ideas for Spring Decorating Job

New York—(U.P.)—With spring redecorating just around the corner, the favorite easy chair is about to bloom into new colors. "If you're not sure what colors to use in your home, stop and think which season of the year you find the most pleasant," suggested Dan Cooper, furniture and fabric designer. "If spring is your favorite time of year, use fresh, clear colors."

A spring-like green chintz, patterned to resemble a half-open Venetian blind, is one new idea for the windows. Off-white horizontal stripes, plus a winding ivy pattern which resembles the ribbons of a Venetian blind actually make the chintz look like a shutter blind. A companion fabric with an all-over ivy pattern against a white background is shown by Schumacher company.

If you pick the colors of fall for your spring redecorating, you'll have plenty of support from fabric designers. They're accenting shades of gold, rust, pumpkin and earth brown this season.

One co-ordinated group of three ranch house fabrics includes a rayon and cotton nubby weave in deep green, a heavy rayon and cotton tweed in rust, with a fleck of gold metallic thread, and a textured plaid in the same rust shade combined with dark beige.

Fabrics Washable. No matter what spring redecorating colors are chosen, the living room can be tailored or fancy, yet completely washable.

Nylon velvet and nylon ratine are two luxury, washable fabrics. One nylon upholstery velvet has subtle line markings, and just as subtle colors—olive, gold, brick and a color called "pine."

Nylon ratine, an open mesh material for glass curtains, will be available for just over \$3 a yard in white or in colors.

Pat Harvey, a decorator who believes the spring cleaning job should be as simple as possible, suggests a budget-priced window treatment in washable plastic.

She designed the koroseal curtains used all through a new model home in Saddlewood Hills, N. J.

"Don't skimp on the material, no matter what it is," she advised. "The effect will be rich if the draperies and curtains are full."

"Windows Tailored" She used pull draperies in flowered plastic on the long windows. Short, high windows were treated with frosty white plastic glass curtains and a patterned, draped valance.

Miss Harvey suggested several remedies for "problem indows," such as the high window in the model home. On those she hung the draped valance above the window, to make them appear larger.

"If you have two or more windows together on one wall of a room, but they're placed off center, drape them as a single unit, then balance the group with a built-in bookcase on the longest wall space," she suggested.

For double windows with a space between, "use a valance across both and then use side draperies. Instead of blinds, use inside shutters painted to match the walls."

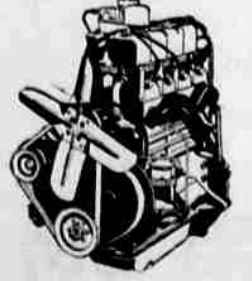
