Rhubarb Should Be Frozen Early For Top Quality. Are you going to can or freeze some of your rhubarb crop?

Freezing Rhubarb: Frozen rhubarb can be used for pie, jam or puddings as well as for sauce.

For best quality, can or freeze your rhubarb early while it has top quality. It will have a better flavor and texture than if you wait until the end of the season.

Rhubarb is easily prepared for freezing. It isn't necessary to remove the skin. Wash and trim it to make your syrup. Cut it into about one-half inch pieces.

To freeze rhubarb for use in preserves or pies, you can pack the rhubarb with either sugar or syrup. For convenience, freeze the amount you use in a pie (or the number of pies you bake at one time) in one container.

Canned Rhubarb: Have you been satisfied with your canned rhubarb?

It isn't necessary to add water to rhubarb when you can it. Add the sugar to the cut rhubarb and let it stand about two hours to draw out juice.

If you want to can any rhubarb by the uncooked method, it will be necessary to use very fresh, young rhubarb.
